

## Notice of lifting visitation restrictions for hospitalized patients and their families

As the influenza epidemic has calmed down,  
we will lift the restriction on visits from Monday, February 17.

### 【Visitation rules】

- ✿ Visits are limited to **3 times a day\*** per patient.
- ✿ Visiting hours are from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm (14:00 to 17:00 ), 15 minutes per visit.  
East 5th floor (special) ward: 1:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. (13:00 - 20:00)
- ✿ One visit is limited to two persons
- ✿ **Visitation is available in the patient's room**

The infection control measure for patients and visitors is as follows

- ① Please be sure to wear a non-woven mask
- ② Please fill out the visitation record in the ward
- ③ Use hand sanitizer when entering and leaving the room  
Our ward nurses will be happy to guide you
- ④ Please adhere to the visiting hours

\*Those who are not allowed to visit

- People who are not feeling well      ● Children under elementary school age
- Those whose family members or close friends have influenza, coronavirus, conjunctivitis, chickenpox, mumps, infectious gastroenteritis, etc.

Thank you for your understanding

\*3 times a day, up to 2 people per time, so please  
understand that the limit is “ 6 persons a day ”



## Request for hand hygiene and wearing a mask

Patients with various illnesses are admitted to the hospital  
From the point of view of infection, the staff of this facility are  
working on infection control measures

Patients suspected of being infected are asked to wear masks  
and practice hand hygiene to prevent themselves from spreading the  
infection to others, and other patients are also asked to wear masks  
and practice hand hygiene to protect themselves from infection  
Eating and drinking are prohibited during the visit

### Visiting Procedures

- ① Please complete the visitation procedure at the following location before your visit.  
Monday-Friday: Outpatient bldg. reception 1F, Weekends & National holidays: East bldg reception 1F
- ② Please come to the ward for visitation with the “Application for Admission/Visiting form”
- ③ When you arrive at the ward, please hand the “Application for Admission/Visit form” to the staff and fill out the visitation list
- ④ A nurse will escort you to your ward  
The staff is going to explain how to disinfect using hand sanitizer  
A nurse will take you to the bedside
- ⑤ Please come to the staff station again after finishing your visit
